



## Notice of Public Information Centre Walter Bean Trail and Pedestrian Footbridge Design and Construction

The City of Kitchener proposes to construct a pedestrian bridge crossing of the Grand River at Doon Valley Golf Course on Doon Valley Drive. The proposed bridge represents a critical link in construction of the Walter Bean Grand River Trail and a significant piece in realizing the vision of a continuous trail system along the river linking the communities of Cambridge, Kitchener and Waterloo.

On September 19, 2005 Kitchener City Council directed that the Community Services Department proceed with detailed design of the Walter Bean Grand River Trail Pedestrian Bridge over the Grand River at the location confirmed through the completed Environmental Assessment for this project; and, that staff present the proposed design for consideration at a future meeting of the Community Services Committee and Council.

The City has been working with R.J. Burnside & Associates, Consulting Engineers, on the design for the pedestrian bridge. The design team would like to present the final design to the public for their review and comment at a Public Information Centre. Your comments are an important part of our design process. A formal presentation of the final design will be made to City Council for final approval.


