SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Outlined below are those policies considered particularly significant.

1. Purpose of the organization

Settler's Grove Community Association was incorporated wiithout share capital on August 25, 1999 under Supplementary Letter Patent.

The purpose of the association is to advance the culture and social interest of the permanent owners and residents of properties in Settler's Grove Community, located in the City of Kitchener, in the Province of Ontario and to carry such activites designed to promote the interests of the owners and residents of Settler's Grove Community, as may be ancillary to the foregoing objects.
